### General Information

The maximal care hospital Ernst von Bergmann (Klinikum EvB) is a future-oriented hospital that offers its patients a wide range of university-level services which are founded on interdisciplinary cooperation. With more than 1,000 beds in 38 medical specialties, it is one of the largest and best-equipped hospitals in the metropolitan region of Berlin/Brandenburg. The hospital's catchment area covers an area of approximately 15,000 km<sup>2</sup> and some 1.5 million inhabitants. Each year more than 1,600 children are born in the hospital, 48,000 emergency cases are treated and 39,500 in-patients find innovative and high-quality medical care. The Ernst von Bergmann Hospital also has extensive out-patient facilities providing specialist out-patient care. Moreover, the hospital operates the a dedicated emergency room for children in the region.

The structure of a maximum care hospital is provided in certified centers such as the Oncology Center, the Vascular Center, the Perinatal Center Level I, and the Interregional Trauma Center as well as in a wide range of intensive care and differentiated surgical departments in all sub-disciplines, including robotic surgery and all subspecialties of internal medicine.

The general hospital Ernst von Bergmann (Klinikum EvB) is currently being transformed into the inter-regional Hospital Group Ernst von Bergmann. In this new arrangement , the Potsdam Hospital clinic now operates three other hospitals located in Potsdam, Bad Belzig and Forst (Lausitz) with more than 1,700 beds and a staff of about 3,500 people all together. In addition, there is a second side for Child and Adolescent Medicine at the Klinikum Westbrandenburg in Brandenburg an der Havel as well as other out-patient clinics, e.g. in Potsdam, Bad Belzig and Forst. In collaboration with the workforce at Bad Belzig and Forst (Lausitz), the target is to upgrade the hospitals to health care parks, thereby preserving and strengthening regional health care in rural areas with the support of the general hospital Ernst von Bergmann (Klinikum EvB) in Potsdam.

The hospital is the cooperation-partner of the Health and Medical University (HMU) in Brandenburg, where there are currently more than 600 medical students in academic education. Moreover we train medical students all over Germany.

The Ernst von Bergmann Hospital is strongly focused on the expansion of clinical research and innovation. To offer our patients modern options of care and therapy, the hospital is currently involved in a large variety of clinical studies in different departments. Furthermore, health science research projects are implemented constantly put into practice. The Ernst von Bergmann Hospital operates comprehensively digital work flows as a partner in different research fields to incorporate artificial intelligence into the health care system.
