

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General Information

The Faculty of Health Sciences Brandenburg (FGW) was founded in 2018 as Joint Faculty of the University of Potsdam, the Brandenburg Medical School Theodor Fontane and the Brandenburg University of Technology Cottbus-Senftenberg. Since then, the faculty has been joined by more than 110 co-opted scientists from its supporting institutions and has appointed four professors — more will follow. Currently, the FGW offers an own PhD program for young scientists in health and life sciences, and accredits three Master's degree programs for students.

The mission of the FGW is to strengthen the cooperation of university and non-university scientists in the state Brandenburg by intensifying joint research collaborations. In this way, innovative and effective concepts for improved health care will be developed in the long term. The facultys research profile is formed by three profile areas:

- Profile area I: Prevention, treatment and rehabilitation
- Profile area II: Health services research with focus on e-Health
- Profile area III: Age-related cellular alterations

These areas cover various research fields ranging from Rehabilitation Medicine, Health Services and Health System Research, Degenerative and Chronic Diseases to Medical Ethics.

Networking and support of health and life research in the state Brandenburg are the core of our activities at the Faculty of Health Sciences. This encompass various networking and exchange initiatives to foster research collaborations as well as translation and transfer for the advancement of Health Sciences. For that reason, we jointly endeavour to make substantial progress in health services and the good for the Brandenburgs rural population.
